Directions to the Miller Senate Office Building 11 Bladen Street, Annapolis, MD 21401-1991

From Baltimore:

I - 97 South to U.S. 50/301 East U.S. 50/301 East to Exit 24, Route 70 - Rowe Blvd. Bear right at bottom of ramp onto Rowe Blvd.

From Washington, D.C.:

U.S. 50/301 East to Exit 24, Route 70 - Rowe Blvd. Bear right at bottom of ramp onto Rowe Blvd.

From the Eastern Shore:

U.S. 50/301 West to Exit 24, Route 70 - Rowe Blvd.

All Follow These Directions Next -

For Navy Stadium parking and trolley-shuttle transportation:

Turn right at the second light onto Taylor Avenue (you will pass stadium on your right). Pass Gates 7 and 6. Turn right into **Gate 5** – Daily Parking. The shuttle stop is near the stadium. There is a \$5 charge to park for the day. Shuttle is \$2.00 each way and leaves every 20 minutes. Note that the shuttle is free for Maryland state employees. Get off the shuttle at the 4th shuttle stop just past the State House on College Avenue. Total cost to part at the Navy Stadium is \$9.00 per day.

To Park in Downtown Annapolis:

Stay on Rowe Blvd and pass through 2 stoplights at Melvin and Taylor. After the second light get in the right lane, cross College Creek, and veer towards the right. At the third light turn right on Calvert Street.

Gotts Garage is on Calvert Street. The entrance will on your left. It is about a 5 minute walk and costs \$15 per day.

Knighton Garage

Continue on Calvert and turn right at the next light, West Street. Go through one light and take the next left on Colonial. The garage will be on your right. The cost is \$10 per day and about a 10 minute walk.


Conference Location

The Miller Senate Office Building is located at 11 Bladen Avenue near intersection of College Avenue and Bladen. It is just ½ block away from the Maryland State House.


***Please Note:
